It appears from the Rolls on file in this Office, that *John Passmeyer* was enrolled on the *20<sup>th</sup>* day of *August*, 1862, at *Jefferson City Mo.*, in *Company G*, *10<sup>th</sup>* Regiment of *Mo. Cavalry* Volunteers, to serve *Three* years, or during the war, and mustered into service as a *Private* from on the *17<sup>th</sup>* day of *December*, 1862, at *Jefferson Barracks Mo.*, in *Company G*, *10<sup>th</sup>* Regiment of *Mo. Cavalry* Volunteers, to serve *Three* years, or during the war. On the Muster Roll of *Company G*, of that Regiment, for the months of *January* and *February*, 1863, he is reported "*Dead at Jefferson City Mo. Dec. 15<sup>th</sup> 1864*"
