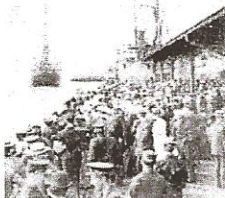

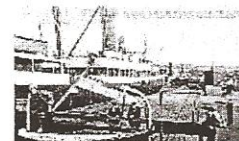

Hilsen til Norge 1905

In 2008 the Vice President of the Norwegian Storting (Norwegian Parliament), Mr Carl I. Hagen made a visit to the Norwegian-American communities in Minneapolis and Chicago. In this regard, the Presidium of the Storting initiated a search in the parliamentary archives for historical documents sent to the Storting by Norwegian immigrants in the United States during the Dissolution of Norway's Union with Sweden in 1905. A selection of the numerous telegrams and letters of congratulation that the Norwegian people and the Storting received from the many Norwegian communities in American in that period of great historical significance to Norway was compiled on a CD presented during the Vice President's visit. The content of this CD has now been made available to the Norway Heritage Community by Arve Wiborg, personal

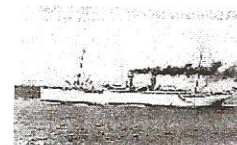

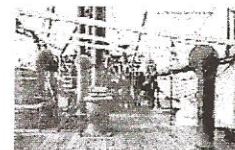

February 25 :
1905 - The S/S Caronia of the Cunard Line departed on her maiden voyage from Liverpool to New York via Queenstown
