- * An asterisk indicates an error on the part of the original recorder, not the transcriber, or is used to call attention to additional information in the passenger notes.
- ? Indicates a letter or number which could not be determined due to the condition of the manifest or handwriting of the original recorder.
- ^ Indicates letters are omitted and the following letter is superscripted.

Spellings have been retained as found in the original, i.e. St Luis for St. Louis.

- 3 Godde (Gödde) has an unlauded o.
- 18 & 19 Possibly the surnames should be the same.
- 20 Should surname be Temme?
- 22-23 Gartner (Gärtner) has an unlauded a.
- 24-25 Surname could be Behrens. The two passengers are listed as from Preussen and Hannover; however, it seems likely they were related and travelling together, so the origin should probably be the same for both.
- 30 Schutte (Schütte) has an unlauded u.
- 33-37 Bartils (Bärtils) has an unlauded a.
- 40 Mohle (Möhle) has an unlauded o.
- 61 Bohings (Böhings) has an unlauded o.
- 70 Schafer (Schäfer) has an unlauded a.
- 74-77 Bodeker (Bödeker) has an unlauded o.
- 79 Muller (Müller) has an unlauded u.
- 80-84 Schaper (Schäper) has an unlauded a.
- 99 Brokern (Brökern) has an unlauded o.
- 101-104 No gender entered for these passengers.
- 105-107 Schofeld (Schöfeld) has an unlauded o.
- 108-115 Luker (Lüker) has an unlauded u.
- 144 Surname is written as Schoer and then a small r is written above and somewhat between the h and the o; hence, the name seems to be Schroer.
- 153-156 Schutte (Schütte) has an unlauded u.
- 164-169 Muller (Müller) has an unlauded u.
- 174-175 Name looks like it might be Adejan or Adefan, but that fourth letter is unclear.
- 192 Note in far right column: she is died on the diarrhea on the 23rd Oct.
- 203 Starting a new page, the writer of this list now gives Preussen as the origin of

the next passengers; it seems like they should be from Hannover like those before them, especially those with the same surname.

218 Kuster (Küster) has an umlauted u.
 225 Holzmigenkauper (Holzmigenkäuper) has an umlauted a.
 227 Muller (Müller) has an umlauted u.
 230-232 Brandtonning (Brandtönning) has an umlauted o.
 245-251 Surname may be Baumann.

Correspondence July 3, 2011 - passengers #199-206 PLASSMEYER (corrected from Bassmeyer)

Following is the e-mail that the transcriber received and after reviewing the manifest agrees that Plassmeyer is indeed the correct spelling:

I greatly appreciate the effort you are putting forth through the ISTG as we have located the ship of our ancestors, the Anna Delius-Bremen To New Orleans-6 November 1857. On that list appears a family listed as Bassmeyer, #199 Heinrich Bassmeyer thru #206 Gerhard Bassmeyer. However the correct spelling is Plassmeyer. Joseph Plassmeyer (#203) is my Great Grandfather. Is there a process through which this can be corrected on the transcribed list? Your work is greatly appreciated. Sincerely, Norb Plassmeyer

Heinrich and Elisabeth Plassmeyer:

Heinrich and Elisabeth (Heckemeyer) Plassmeyer and six children left Benteler (Prussia) in August 1857 and arrived at New Orleans on 6 November 1857. They then traveled up the Mississippi, the Missouri and the Osage rivers and arrived at Westphalia, Osage County, Missouri in late December 1857. Anton, Joseph, and Johann later served in the Union army, and Herman joined the enrolled militia. Elizabeth married Peter Gelven. Gerhard was a farmer and public official in Osage County and the Missouri Legislature. Anton was captured at Missionary Ridge near Chattanooga and died at Andersonville prison in 1864. Johann contracted illness around Vicksburg and died at Jefferson City also in 1864. Joseph became ill during the fighting in northern Mississippi in 1862, was discharged and later married and became a farmer in Osage County. Descendants of Joseph, Elisabeth, and Gerhard remain in Osage County and other places in America.
